MUW received official word from SACS in a letter dated January 6, 2005. No additional reports are requested. Dr. Mark Bean provided PIE Council members with a copy of this official SACS letter. Dr. Claudia Limbert has accepted a position to the 77 member Commission on Colleges and the 11 member SACS Executive Committee.

Dr. Sam Gingerich provided an update on the Academic Planning Process. Last fall, a steering committee was appointed and initial meetings held. Working groups have been formed to analyze specific areas and the summaries from these groups will shape the planning process. The goal is for the process to be completed by the end of the spring 2005 semester.

Mark Bean provided an update on the W-2009 strategic objectives. The W-2009 strategic objectives were reviewed during the December President's Cabinet retreat. Dr. Limbert, then, reviewed and finalized the strategic objectives. The final draft will be posted next week. The next components in the process will be to develop specific steps; assign responsible personnel; set timelines, assessment criteria, and estimated costs. An updated copy of the strategic objectives will be posted in approximately one week.

PIE Council reviewed the ACT Survey of Student Opinion. PIE Council members were asked to compare this survey with the 2004 MUW Student Satisfaction Survey. ACT gives MUW the option of adding thirty questions to their survey.

Members gave suggestions from last year's survey that should be included as part of the thirty questions.
