PIE Council approved the minutes from the November 11, 2005 meeting. Jennifer Moore did a short PowerPoint presentation on the results of the spring 2005 ACT Survey of Student Opinions. The results showed that MUW is doing well overall in comparison to its peers. In fact, in many categories, MUW outranked its peers in terms of student satisfaction.
