The Columbus Fire Department responded to a fire in Reneau Hall this morning at about 7 a.m. The fire was isolated and contained to one room on the second floor. A staff member noticed the smell of smoke and reported the smell to the MUW Police Department who then notified 911. The actual cause of the fire and extent of the damage are still being assessed.
