Bulletin Issued: July 12, 2024

The Columbus Police Department is investigating an incident after W employees reported hearing gunshots Wednesday, July 10 at 3:47 p.m. The W Police Department immediately responded after being notified by 911 of a shots fired call in the area of 11th Street and Sixth Avenue South. A W staff member also reported the incident to 911.

W employees reported seeing a teal blue Dodge Charger traveling north, at a high rate of speed, along 10th Street, but were not able to get a physical description of the occupants. Campus police were later informed that university property was damaged as part of the incident.

The W Police Department is cooperating with the Columbus Police Department in this ongoing investigation.
