### **Minutes**

**Approval of the March 2024 Minutes** – Russell Brandon motioned to move the minutes as presented. Brandy Larmon seconded that motion and Academic Council approved the minutes as presented.

**RSI Results** – Russell Brandon shared the RSI Survey Results for Spring 2024 with the Academic Council Board. He explained that the survey went above what is required for the baseline and that the results are still being configured. The survey includes statistics on direct instruction, instructor feedback, announcements, contact information, and grading. Professors who teach online and/or online hybrid courses were required to complete the survey.

Trellis Financial Wellness Survey Results – Dr. Whitehead presented the results of the Trellis Financial Wellness Survey, which was completed in Fall 2023. Survey results demonstrate students' level of financial need and the resources they need to be academically successful. It was noted that the MUW response rate was close to the national average. Most schools complete the survey every 2-3 years. The MUW "Basic Needs" page (<a href="https://www.muw.edu/basics/">https://www.muw.edu/basics/</a>) was also discussed, which has several resources including food, financial, wellness, connection, safety, and academic. The Council Board mentioned conducting a session where the survey results and "Basic Needs" page are shared with faculty members to help students who need the support.

**Lifelong Learner Policy** – Shannon Lucius provided the Academic Council Board with the Lifelong Learner Program link that is posted on the School of Education website and made a proposal for the Bulletin. This program allows individuals who are not seeking a degree the opportunity to enroll in specific courses they are interested in for professional development. There is a code entered in Banner for this when they apply. Russell Brandon motioned to approve the Lifelong Learner Policy with edits from the Council and Amanda Clay Powers seconded the motion.

**Last Date of Attendance** – Resources and information regarding the last date of attendance was emailed to the Academic Council Board prior to the meeting. This included policies from several different Universities. During the meeting, it was discussed that opening a file, browsing a power point, clicking on a video, etc. counts as

attendance. There does not need to be a policy made; however, faculty need to be made aware of this and will probably discuss during Fall Development. Dr. Tollison mentioned that Canvas resources can be used to identify last date of attendance.
